Provider Type 86 Created for Specialized Foster Care Services

A new Nevada Medicaid provider type has been created for providers performing Intensive In-Home Supports and Services and Crisis Stabilization Services to Nevada Medicaid recipients within a Specialized Foster Care setting that are deemed eligible for these services. The policy, coverage and limitations for Specialized Foster Care (provider type 86) are specified in <u>Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 4000</u>.

Effective immediately, eligible providers may enroll in this new provider type and bill for services. The following documents have been posted on the Nevada Medicaid provider website to assist providers in enrolling in and billing Specialized Foster Care services:
